FORGIVING WHAT YOU CAN'T FORGET:
Discover How to Move On, Make Peace with Painful
Memories, and Create a Life That's Beautiful Again

By Lysa TerKeurst (234.5 Te)

The author begins this book with this statement: *"The more our pain consumes us, the more it will control us."* It is a powerful message, with this book offering to guide the reader on a path forward. ...*"[I]sn't it odd that, though forgiveness is a major part of Christian faith, most of us have never been taught much about it."* (p.17) The author details the ways in which true forgiveness and peace can be achieved.

On page 202, TerKeurst observes: *"Not forgiving someone isn't teaching the other person a lesson, nor is it protecting you in any way. It's making the choice to stay in pain. It's ratcheting the already too-tight belt tighter with each remembrance. Undealt-with pain and a mind at peace cannot coexist."* Forgiveness is often hard. But the peace that follows can be beautiful.
