Love Has a Name:
Learning to love the different,
the difficult & everyone else
By Adam Weber (#241 We)

In John 13:34-35, Jesus calls us: *A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so must you love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples.*

So there it is, to be a Christian is to love one another. This book reflects on how difficult it is to fulfill that requirement. It starts with recognizing someone's personhood by calling them by their name. A person's name is a powerful tool in getting to know and to love them, as we are commanded by Jesus to do.

"Have you ever based your thoughts about a group of people off the actions of one? Ever generalized? (p. 48)... When we practice a love that doesn't generalize, we end up seeing people for who they truly are, not who we've assumed they are." (p. 49)
